

**Randall School PTC
Meeting Minutes
May 9th, 2016**

1. Everyone was welcomed and the meeting was called to order at 6:33pm by Natalie B.

2. Secretary's Report: The April meeting minutes were approved by Colleen K. and seconded by Elizabeth Y.

3. President's Report

A. Natalie B. asked for nominations for the 2016-2017 PTC Board. There were none, and the current board was officially announced as the board for next year.

B. Natalie B. asked for funding and fundraiser suggestions for next year. There was discussion on many ideas, including teacher wishlist funding and extracurriculars such as Lego League.

4. Treasurer's Report

A. Account Balances: Jodi K. went over the account balances.

B. Check Approval: Jodi K. asked for approval to write a check payable to Laurie DeMoon for \$1,094.46 for Ice Cream Social and Teacher Appreciation, approved by Elizabeth Y. and seconded by Kim B.

C. Budget: Jodi K. went over the budget as of May 9th. Colleen K. made a correction to the 8th grade promotion line. Jodi announced the PTC brought in \$68,366.35 this school year to support our students, teachers, and parents. She thanked everyone in the Randall community for volunteering, donating, and supporting the PTC.

5. Principal's Report: Mrs. Zigler thanked the PTC for teacher appreciation week and said the meals were very much appreciated by teachers and staff. She said the new Gaga Ball court is a huge success, with about 100 kids lined up to participate at each recess. She said Mr. Perry has been attending recess to referee and assist kids in playing. She said the grass is quickly becoming worn and blacktop will be needed. She also said all other new playground purchases are being used and loved.

6. Event Recap

A. Ice Cream Social: Laurie D. gave a summary of the ice cream social, including 199 meals were sold and 300 bowls of ice cream. Mrs. Zigler said next year's event date will be May 4th.

B. Teacher Appreciation: Laurie D. and Erin T. gave a recap of teacher appreciation week, and said the teachers & staff were very, very appreciative of the meals. There was discussion on adjustments for next year including budget and food sources.

7. Fundraising
